SUBJECT: Operating Capital/Major Maintenance Carryovers (Informational Only)

## **CARRYOVER PROCESS**

On November 6, the Office of the Comptroller requested that departments submit operating appropriations (and related revenues) that they want to have carried over from 2023 to 2024. The table below lists the carryovers that were received as of December 27.

For operating carryovers of capital/major maintenance appropriations, the Office of the Comptroller provides informational reports for the January and March committee cycles. These reports summarize carryovers that have been identified by departments and list the corresponding funding sources. Any unencumbered capital outlay/major maintenance appropriations that are not submitted to the Office of the Comptroller will be lapsed.

Section 32.91 of the Milwaukee County General Ordinances states that appropriations for capital expenditures or major repair shall remain in force until the purpose for which the appropriation was made has been accomplished or abandoned.

#### **Parks**

The Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture has submitted appropriations of \$330,260 of major maintenance/capital outlay funds to be carried over to 2024.

- \$211,260 is being requested for lead paint removal, lead fixture replacements, wading pool conversions, pavilion improvements, and ADA restroom improvements.
- \$14,000 is being requested for Lincoln Park and Carver Park pole barn projects. This funding is necessary to complete the utility connections for the project that cannot be completed until spring.
- \$105,000 is being requested for the Lake Park Service Storm Sewer project. This project provides repairs to a failed sewer connection at Lake Park Service.

### **Department of Transportation – Transportation Services Division**

The Division of Transportation Services has requested to carryover \$44,561 of major maintenance/capital outlay funds to be carried over to 2024. The funds will be used to finance renovations at the Milwaukee County Lapham office location. These appropriations may also finance furniture, fixtures, and equipment.

#### Recommendation

This report is informational only. The Office of the Comptroller will process these carryovers, so the appropriations are available in 2024.

The Office of the Comptroller will provide the Finance Committee an additional listing of Carryovers that it receives for the March Committee cycle.
