The 2022 Adopted Capital improvement Budget included an appropriation for the replacement of the Irrigation System at Whitnall Park Golf Course.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds were awarded to Milwaukee County Parks to fund replacement of Cart Paths at Whitnall Park Golf Course.

Project Goals

- Replace irrigation system

- Revise cart parking, ingress and egress
- Reconstruct all tee areas, greens and sand bunkers
- Improve drainage and hillside seepage in select areas
- Selective tree management to improve turf health
- Add practice facility
- Enhance and add native planting / wetland areas
- Improve pre- and post-round amenities at Clubhouse



Q: Why does the driving range have to be right there?

A: Other options, including the toboggan run and along the current parkway corridor were considered – but the current location offers the most yardage, least impacts to natural resources and other current uses and will facilitate easy staffing, maintenance and operations

Q: Will the driving range contribute to the finances of Whitnall Park Golf Course?

A: Yes! Milwaukee County Parks operates driving ranges at Brown Deer, Oakwood and Dretzka. Respective revenue, year-to-date, is \$49,664, \$35,538 and \$10,349.
