Dear Colleagues:


I have prepared the "compromise" redistricting plan. Since no one else seems to be moving forward with the obvious reduction to 17 on the announcement of the two known vacancies, I have taken the liberty of proposing such a move. I have tried to respect all supervisory districts while at the same time trying to straighten out some of the meandering, serpentine lines that have resulted over the history of redistricting while also incorporating the new census figures. I had no ulterior motive in drawing the new lines other than to permit surrounding districts to absorb the vacated districts of DeBruin and Holloway and honor the realization that the southern region of the county has experienced growth, both of these facts were ignored in the plan for 18.

Please consider this plan as an alternative to the committee's recommended plan of 18. If we are given more time for further review, I may submit another plan that I have been looking at as well, but have not had the time for sufficient development. Since the actions of Thursday's board meeting are unknown at the time, I wanted to make sure this compromise was before the board. Thank you for the courtesy of considering this plan.
