Key-Hodges decentralized occupant to the ground and stabilized her until responding staff, Deputy Proeber arrived to assist. Occupant was secured, Deputy Proeber and Ofc. Grisby assisted her to her feet and escorted her out of the housing unit to the floor control.

- 2117: While tending to a medical emergency in 5D, PSW Sarah informed me that occupant made statements that he was self-harming to her. Occupant was placed on suicide watch due to threats to self-harm if he did not get his 10 mil. of Abilify. He was escorted to 4D awaiting his housing assignment.
