2024 Budget Amendment 42

→ "Amend the narrative of Agency 900 – Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture to include the language as follows: An appropriation of \$500,000 is included in an allocated contingency account within the department to pay for park enhancements. The department shall provide a list of recommendations to the County Board of Supervisors for review and approval no later than the March 2024 meeting cycle. The projects should include high-priority enhancements to activate park spaces which, among other things, may include better lighting for safety and splash pad access."

Amendment 42 Request for Funding from Contingency

1. Tiefenthaler Park Improvements (\$100,000) - planning and design to upgrade wading pool, contingency for soil remediation, planning lighting upgrades, and contingency for the completion of the ARPA funded pathway repaving


2. Seasonal Labor Increase (\$100,000) – adding seasonal staff to ensure facility openings



Amendment 42 Request for Funding from Contingency

3. High Impact Strategic Plan Implementation Projects
(\$100,000) — more information will be provided on Parks' 3Year Strategic Plan, specific items within it to be supported by
this funding include — adding striping to existing tennis courts
to accommodate pickleball, painting basketball courts,
developing comprehensive plans for individual parks, providing
free picnic areas that will require a revenue offset.





Amendment 42 Request for Funding from Contingency

- 4. Pavilion Upgrades (\$80,000) –kitchen fixture enhancements
- **5. Walker Square Park Improvements (\$50,000)** turf grass and park infrastructure enhancements
- **6. Seasonal Labor Recruitment and Retention Incentives (\$50,000)** funding to ensure that recruitment incentives can continue throughout 2024 to better recruit and staff facilities
- 7. Community Center Exercise Equipment (\$20,000)
