22 23 24	WHEREAS, one component of Family Care enables counties to serve as an Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC), to support both individuals with disabilities, ages 18 to 59, and older adults; and

32 33 34 35 36 37 38 39	WHEREAS, as part of the 2023-2025 State Budget, the State Legislature approved a permanent increase of \$7.5 million in Statewide funding for ADRCs over the biennium, and this increase, along with an updated allocation formula that considers health equity factors such as percentage of poverty, have resulted in an additional \$1,599,065 to Milwaukee County's 2024 ADRC contract, after many years of underfunding; and
