The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:
SECTION 1. Sections 46.12 to 46.18 of the General Ordinances of

ing Committee There is a creation of a county and cities housing committee to exchange information with, and promote distogue among, hous-ing advocates and other individuals with lived experiences related to housing security and governmental officials that effectuate programs. The committee may develop recommendations related to housing policies, procedures, and practices for local policymakers to review and con-

akier. 46.14. Composition.

(1) The committee shall be comprised of twenty-one (21) rolling members including eight (8) ex officio. members or their designess and thirteen (13) community, spoolntees. The ex-officio members shall include:

munity members.
(1) The Milwaukee County (1) The Milwaukee County Executive shall appoint six (6) community members subject to confirmation by the Milwaukee Gounty Board of Supervisors and the City of Milwaukee Mayor shall appoint seven (7) members subject to confirmation by the Milwaukee Common Council.

(2) Terms and vecancies. The constant members shall such

community members shall each be appointed to a two-year term and may be reappointed for two additional terms. Commu-nity members may not serve more than three two-year terms
(a)x years). Yecancies, occurring because of resignation or
other valid reasons will be filled
by appointment of a successor for the unexpired term of the vacated office. Members may continue to serve past the end of their term for up to sixty (60) days if no new appointment or reappointment has been made by the appointing authority and

(2) Gualifications, Community members shall have a primary residence in Milwaukee County and possess a proficioney in housing related issues or have lived experiences with homelessness or eyiciton. At least one of the Milwaukee County Executive appointers shall have appointers shall have sand the control of the Milwaukee County Executive appointers shall have Executive appointees shall have a crimary residence in a commu-nity with a population less than 80.000 residents. The Milwaukes County, Executive, and City of Hilwaukes Mayor, shall ensure no more than one (1) of their respective appointments serve as a landford or in a capacity that advocates for landfords.

48.16. Organization.
The committee shall procased to elect co-chairpersons; one from the ilst of ex officio members and one from the community member appoint-ments. These elected committee co-chairpersons shall each serve a term of two (2) years or until their appointment lapses per Section 46.15(2), whichever comes first. The committee may re-elect a chairperson for successive terms, but a com-munity member, may not serve as chair for more than two two-

year terms (four years). Vacancles in the co-chairperson roles shall be fitted for the remainder of the unexpired term. In the absence of a co78 chairperson, the other co-chairperson may fulfill the duties of the goaltion. The co-chairpersons shall coordinate who shall preside at all meetings of the committee and other duties that may be required. The committee may adopt bylaws of procedure by an affirmative vote of 14 or more

members.
