ADD AND/OR DELETE AS FOLLOWS:

Amend the WHEREAS clauses beginning on or near line 18 as follows:

WHEREAS, the make-up of the Youth Commission consists of at least one (1) commissioner per supervisory district and two (2) appointed co-chairs ~~but does not include residents aged 14-18 who have experienced housing insecurity;~~ and

~~WHEREAS, at the meeting of the Youth Commission on February 21, 2024, the Commissioners voted to request the County Board create an additional seat to represent youth that have experienced housing insecurity or are currently experiencing housing insecurity; and~~

Amend the BE IT RESOLVED clause that begins on or near line 42 as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby amends Chapter 106 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to ~~create an additional Commissioner for the County Commission on Youth for someone who has or is experiencing housing insecurity and~~ create an expedited on-boarding process for appointees by adoption of the following:

Amend the Ordinance beginning on or near line 54 as follows:

106.03 – Selection of Commissioners.

(2) *Selection Committee.* Upon adoption of this ordinance, an initial selection committee shall be created to select the first youth commissioners. The initial selection committee will consist of two (2) adults and three (3) youth (age eighteen (18) or under) who will be jointly appointed by the county executive and the county board chairperson. The initial selection committee shall review all applications by utilizing published criteria and interview prospective commissioners. The initial selection committee shall ~~appoint the first commissioners, submit the names of the first commissioners to the county board for confirmation.~~ Once seated, the commission on youth will appoint from within its ranks a selection committee of not less than five (5) commissioners. The selection committee will determine when applications may be submitted, conduct application reviews, interview candidates, and ~~make appointments to the commission, submit n~~Names of the appointees shall be submitted to the county board of supervisors ~~for confirmation as an informational report.~~ An appointee may immediately serve as a commissioner for up to 90 days while county board confirmation is pending. In the event that an insufficient number of applications are received, the remainder of the commission shall be jointly appointed by the county executive and county board chairperson ~~and confirmed by the county board of supervisors.~~

(3) *Qualifications.* At the time of selection, commissioners shall be a resident of Milwaukee County and shall:

- (a) Have achieved high school status;
- (b) Currently attend high school or alternative school; and
- (c) Have met other qualification criteria as established by the commission under section 106.04

(4) *Commission make up.* The commission shall be made up of at least twenty (20) youth including:

- (a) At least one (1) commissioner per supervisory district
- (b) County board chairperson appointee will serve as co-chair
- (c) County executive appointee will serve as co-chair.
- ~~(d) One (1) commissioner who has experienced housing insecurity or is currently experiencing housing insecurity.~~
