SUBJECT: Airport Reimbursement Resolution

Background

In April 2010, an appropriation transfer of \$500,000 was approved that increased expenditure authority and revenue for Project WA108 HVAC Replacement. Financing was to be provided by general airport revenue bonds. The September 2010 airport revenue bond issuance did not include this amount.

This reimbursement resolution will allow spending to occur prior to the issuance of bonds at a later time.

Since the Airport will need to proceed with these projects, the County will have to reimburse itself with bond proceeds for expenditures that are incurred prior to the issuance of the bonds.

U.S. Treasury Regulation Compliance

U.S. Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 describes the conditions under which the County may expend County funds on a project currently and later reimburse itself with bond proceeds. The first step in providing for such reimbursement to occur is an expression of intent by the County to reimburse itself for expenditures incurred prior to issuing the bonds. Therefore, the attached resolution expresses that intent.

Expressing this intent will allow the County to reimburse itself for expenditures incurred as far back as 60 days prior to the approval of the attached reimbursement resolution.

Recommendation


The DAS recommends that the Finance and Audit Committee approve the accompanying resolution that expresses the County's intent, in accordance with U.S. Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2, to reimburse itself for expenditures that will occur prior to the issuance of the bonds. Since some spending will have occurred outside of the 60-day reimbursement window only a portion of the expenses will be eligible to be paid for with bond proceeds. Any expenses paid prior to 60 days before the adoption of the reimbursement resolution will be financed by cash from the Airport Reserve Account. Airport staff will provide the Department of Administrative Services with a list of expenses that occurred within 60-days of or after the adoption of the reimbursement resolution prior to the completion of the preliminary official statement for the next airport revenue bond issuance.

A. In April 2010, an appropriation transfer of \$500,000 was approved to increase the scope of work for Project WA108 HVAC Replacement.

The additional work associated with the appropriation transfer for was not included in the September 2010 Airport Revenue Bond Issue and therefore will need to be included in a future bond issue. Since the Airport will need to proceed with the project, the County will have to reimburse itself with bond proceeds for expenditures that are paid prior to the issuance of the bonds. Any expenses paid prior to 60 days before the adoption of the reimbursement resolution will be financed by cash from the Airport Reserve Account.
