11	WHEREAS, Fiscal Trends was an annual soft-cover publication last produced
12	by the Department of Administrative Services in 1999 that outlined and evaluated
13	financial trends affecting Milwaukee County; and
14 15	WHEREAS, these trend indicators included areas such as: community needs
13 16	and resources, county expenditures, county revenues, property taxes, operating
17	position, employee pension system and debt structure/condition of capital facilities; and
18	position, employee pension system and debt structure/condition of capital racinities, and
19	WHEREAS, each of the approximately 30 trends was given a conclusion rating
20	of positive, monitor or warning, which provided policymakers insight on fiscal indicators
21	that may be most urgent; and

23	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County is seeking to be more strategic in its decision
24	making process and having access to information that was contained in the Fiscal
25	Trends report would allow policymakers to focus on broader trends that may need to be
26	addressed; and

28	WHEREAS, with a renewed focus on strategic planning efforts, the publication
29	of Fiscal Trends could serve as a key piece of information for policymakers to consider
30	as they weigh County issues; now, therefore,
