A SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION

To substitute for item presented under suspension

To clarify and extend, on an emergency and non-precedential basis, employee compensation and benefits policies to employees formerly represented by District Council 48 (DC48) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), in order to avoid administrative confusion and uncertainty, until the County Board adopts applicable policies.

WHEREAS, at the time of consideration of this resolution, AFSCME either will have been, or is expected soon to be, decertified by the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission as a collective bargaining unit and as the bargaining representative for its members (hereinafter referred to as "former members"), and

WHEREAS, the 2007-08 collective bargaining agreement between Milwaukee County and AFSCME contains numerous provisions related to compensation and fringe benefits that would immediately become inapplicable to those former members of AFSCME upon decertification of the union, and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has enacted some ordinance amendments in 2011 containing policies related to some compensation and fringe benefits of former AFSCME members, but that Milwaukee County has not yet reviewed and enacted policies with respect to all compensation and fringe benefit subjects covered by the 2007-08 collective bargaining agreement, and

WHEREAS, this resolution and ordinance is adopted for the sole purpose of avoiding significant administrative uncertainty and confusion that might exist without its adoption, and is expressly intended not to be precedential with respect to any matter contained herein, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is intended to be effective only upon the decertification of AFSCME and only until such time as Milwaukee County enacts policies on these subjects for these former members, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, to codify this emergency and temporary policy, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts Section 17.015 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances by adopting the following:
