(ITEM ) From the Department of Labor Relations, submitting documents relating to the tentative agreement with District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, by recommending adoption of the following:

### A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the negotiation staff of the Personnel Committee of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors and District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, have reached an agreement on all issues relating to base wages for employees in the bargaining unit represented by District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, modifying the previous agreement in the following respects:

- (1) Providing for the termination of the Agreement on December 31, 2012.
- (2) Providing for no wage increases for 2012.

(3) Due to Act 10 any of the provisions of the MOA which are now prohibited subjects of bargaining will no longer be part of the previous MOA.

WHEREAS, such agreement was ratified by the membership of District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers on September XX, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel and Audit, on September XX, 2012, recommended approval (vote X-X) of the District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers agreement; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the agreement on base wages with District No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers which is incorporated herein by reference to this File No. 12-XXX, and hereby authorizes and directs the County Executive and the County Clerk to execute the agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Administration is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit appropriation transfer requests reflecting this agreement at a later date, if necessary.

## 1.04 DURATION OF AGREEMENT

- The provisions of this Agreement shall become effective on January 1, 2012 (1) unless otherwise herein provided. Unless otherwise modified or extended by mutual agreement of the parties, this Agreement shall expire on December 31, 2012.
- The initial bargaining proposals of the County and the Union for a successor (2) agreement shall be exchanged prior to November 1, 2011 at a time mutually agreeable to the parties. Thereafter, negotiations shall be carried on in an expeditious manner and shall continue until all bargainable issues between the parties have been resolved.
- (3) This timetable is subject to adjustment by mutual agreement of the parties consistent with the progress of negotiations.
