In July 2012, the County Board adopted a resolution (File No. 12-561) allocating \$242,087 to ZiaPartners, Inc. for technical assistance associated with the implementation of key mental health redesign recommendations. It is anticipated that any assistance provided by ZiaPartners to develop the detailed, data-driven implementation plan directed in this resolution would be covered under the existing contract.
