- A. Approval of the requested amendment is to extend the professional services contract between Joxel Group, LLC (TJG) and the Information Management Services Division (IMSD) for the continuation of the Electronic Medical Records (EMR) implementation for the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)- Behavioral Health Division (BHD). This action will result in an increased cost of \$615,685.
- B. The cost related to the proposed contract amendment is an additional \$615,685 for the 2013 Implementation Services of the broader project. IMSD and BHD are recommending that the additional funding of \$615,685 necessary to complete the professional services contract for 2013 project management, business analyst and interface analyst services of the Implementation phase be funded through BHD operating funds
- C. The requested funds are included in the BHD 2013 operating budget. IMSD will return to the County Board and the County Executive for approval of the costs to fund, 2014, the final phase of the project.
- D. The expenditures provided above are estimated. It is assumed that the overall Electronic Medical Records (EMR) project may require future budget appropriation requests to complete.
