Approval of this request will allow the Director of DHHS to execute a 2013 professional services contract with Quick Financial Solutions LLC to continue provision of contracted Children's Long Term Support (CLTS) Medicaid Waiver fiscal management, the required review of provider agency audits and other fiscal monitoring activities.
