









Beginning in the mid-1950s, the southern end of Milwaukee County's General Mitchell International Airport (MKE) was home to the 440th Airlift Wing of the Air Force Reserve. In 2008, the base was closed as part of the federal Base Realignment and Closure Act. Today, in its place is Milwaukee County's MKE Regional Business Park.



MKE Regional Business Park offers convenient access to Milwaukee County's General Mitchell International Airport, southeastern Wisconsin and northern Illinois, plus easy access to all transport modes:

- > Port of Milwaukee
- > Milwaukee County Transit System
- > Chicago and Milwaukee via I-94
- > College Avenue corridor
- > Lake Parkway

With approximately 175,000 square feet of building space available for lease, MKE Regional Business Park has space available to accommodate a wide range of uses in sizes from 500 to 25,000 square feet.

MKE Regional Business Park has 15 to 20 acres available for potential development.
