As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Watertown Plank Road Interchange is being reconstructed. The project team appreciates your patience, and will work diligently to inform all stakeholders about the sequence of work and specific impacts.

We look forward to working closely with you to ensure that the work is completed with the least amount of disruption as possible.

A general outline of what to expect in the coming weeks is listed below.

Week of 10/28/13

Watertown Plank Road

- New traffic patterns in effect east of Discovery Parkway
- Begin median removals and place base aggregate at medians
- Continue Connell Connection Road paving at Behavioral Health
- Removals at 87th Street and 92nd Street and place base aggregate and temporary pavement
- Pile driving continues at pedestrian bridge
- Traffic placed on outside lanes

US 45 / Interchange

- Complete traffic switch on US 45
- Grading and storm sewer in northeast quadrant
- Continue pile driving at the new US 45 Northbound Bridge over Watertown Plank Road

Frontage Road & Adjacent Parking Lots

Parking structure Level B closure

Week of 11/4/13

Watertown Plank Road

- Placement of temporary pavement
- Pile driving continues at pedestrian bridge

US 45 / Interchange

- Drill east shaft for storm sewer tunneling
- Stage 1A / 1B switch
- Continue pile driving at the new US 45 Northbound Bridge over Watertown Plank Road

Frontage Road & Adjacent Parking Lots

- Removal of existing pavement
- Begin storm sewer work
- Parking structure Level B closure

Week of 11/11/13

Watertown Plank Road

Begin work on south stair tower for pedestrian bridge

US 45 / Interchange

Installation of storm sewer in the SE quadrant

Frontage Road & Adjacent Parking Lots

- Parking structure Level C closure
- Begin paving

NORTHBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP CLOSING OCTOBER 12, 2013


Swan Boulevard northbound, from Watertown Plank Road to Discovery Parkway, as well as **the Watertown Plank Road northbound entrance ramp to US 45, will be closing Saturday, October 12.** The northbound entrance ramp to US 45 will remain closed until Fall 2014, as part of the Watertown Plank Road Interchange project.

Access to northbound and southbound Swan Boulevard will re-open late 2013 on the newly configured roadway west of US 45, adjacent to Innovation Drive.

As part of the Swan Boulevard reconstruction, Underwood Parkway will be closed November 4 - 15. Access will be maintained to businesses in the area.


Route to US 45 NB

WATERTOWN PLANK ROAD NEW

Watertown Plank Road Interchange/Watertown Plank Road Innovation Drive to 87th Street

As part of the Zoo Interchange Project, the Watertown Plank Road Interchange will be reconstructed from October 2013 to late Fall 2014. Work will include the full closure of Watertown Plank Road, under US 45, and all of the entrance and exit ramps.

Use US 45, Wisconsin Avenue, North Avenue, and WIS 100 to get around the closure. Local traffic on Watertown Plank Road should use the new Discovery Parkway and Swan Boulevard to access Watertown Plank Road, east and west of US 45.
