This award is in the amount of \$156,848 for provision of Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and Trauma Informed Care in the Milwaukee County Drug Treatment Court and results in an increase in the original Org. Unit 2900 2014 approved budget. A competitive request for proposals will be issued for these services.
