12	A RESOLUTION

14 15	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County owns a former landfill in the City of Franklin that was closed in 1981 and a former landfill under what is now Doyne Park that was closed in
16	1976; and
17	
18 19	WHEREAS, the former landfill sites presented environmental and public health concerns due to their generation of landfill gas and leachate; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources required Milwaukee
22	County to install, operate and maintain landfill gas control systems at the former landfill
23	sites in order to comply with Chapters NR 500 to 520, Wisconsin Administrative Code;
24	and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the County Board, in late 1996, authorized construction of the gas
27	collection and venting system for the Doyne Park landfill and, in early 1997, authorized
28	construction of the gas collection and flare system, landfill cap, and vegetative cover for the
29 30	Franklin landfill; and
30 31	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has continued to effectively operate and maintain
32	the gas control systems since 1998 with the assistance of professional services contractors;
33	and
34	
35	WHEREAS, in October 2013, Milwaukee County issued a Request for Proposals for
36	the operation and maintenance of both landfills, with proposals due on November 13,
37	2013; and
38	
39	WHEREAS, the proposal review team reviewed the proposals and selected SCS
40	Engineers based on qualifications; and
41	
42	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County will award the selected consultant two not-to-exceed
43	contracts, one for each landfill; the sum of these contracts is \$103,015; and the contract is
44	for one year; and

- 45 WHEREAS, the contract provides for two one-year extensions if the services are 46 47 performed adequately; and 48 49 WHEREAS, SCS Engineers meets the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal of 17 percent established for this project; and 50 51 52 WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy and Environment, at its meeting of 53 December 10, 2013, recommended adoption of the Department's request (vote 7-0); and 54 55 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel and Audit, at its meeting of December 16, 2013, also recommended adoption of the Department's request (vote 9-0); 56 now, therefore, 57 58 59 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director, Department of Administrative Services, to enter into a Professional 60 Services Agreement with SCS Engineers for operation and maintenance of landfill systems 61 62 for the one-year period beginning January 15, 2014, with the possibility to extend two more years through January 15, 2017, if the consultant performs adequately. 63 64 65 66 ag
