11	WHEREAS, due to unforeseen spalling of concrete in the Tropical Dome (Dome)
12	that occurred in late August 2013, the Dome is closed until engineers and contractors can
13	fully inspect, secure, and repair the reinforced concrete frame; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, while the frame is not in danger of collapse, there are edge pieces that
16	are popping off next to the steel plates that secure the glazing system for the Dome and
17	these pieces are sharp and can fall from as high as 80 feet, creating a hazard; and
18	W/HEREAS, high troop and donce plant life make it difficult to get equipment into the
19 20	WHEREAS, high trees and dense plant life make it difficult to get equipment into the Dome and placed appropriately; and
20	Dome and placed appropriately, and
21	WHEREAS, after a lengthy search, a lift was located in Chicago and in preparation,
23	trees have been pruned and the ground stabilized in areas to secure the outriggers; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the inspection and repairs needed within the Dome,
26	the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture (DPRC) and the Department of
27	Administrative Services - Architectural, Engineering and Environmental Services (DAS-
28	AE&ES) have engaged Graef-USA and Nagy Restoration to complete the needed work; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, at this time, it is anticipated that both firms will remain within the
31	quoted amounts; however, if any unforeseen conditions were to arise, the DPRC and DAS-
32	AE&ES staff are requesting the authority to increase the Graef-USA professional services
33	contract to up to \$200,000 for this project; and
34 25	WHEREAS the Committee on Perks Energy and Environment at its meeting of
35 36	WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy and Environment, at its meeting of December 10, 2013, recommended adoption of the Department's request (vote 7-0); and
