A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Greenfield Historical Society (GHS), founded on June 25, 1965, is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation that is affiliated with the Wisconsin Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, GHS's purposes are to collect and preserve library materials, artifacts, manuscripts, and photographs, maintain historic buildings, and conduct educational programs pertaining to the history of the former Town of Greenfield and the City of Greenfield; and

WHEREAS, GHS has requested permission to install a sign summarizing the importance of the Root River Parkway in the development of Milwaukee County and the City of Greenfield; and

WHEREAS, GHS will purchase, install, and maintain the marker at no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) has evaluated the appropriateness of installing this marker in the Parkway and determined that it will be a meaningful cultural addition; and

WHEREAS, the DPRC Director recommends that DPRC be authorized to accept the donation of the historical marker from GHS and that appropriate Milwaukee County staff be authorized to prepare, review, approve, execute, record, and/or implement the required documents or perform actions to facilitate the acceptance and installation of the marker; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) is authorized to accept the donation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that DPRC, the Department of Administrative Services, Risk Management, Corporation Counsel, and Register of Deeds are authorized to prepare, review, approve, execute, record all documents, and to perform all actions required to facilitate the installation of this marker; and
