15	The positions of constitutional officers within Milwaukee County include		
16	the following: sheriff, clerk of circuit court, county treasurer, register of deeds,		
17	and the county clerk. It is recognized that the incumbents of these positions		
18	serve as the department head and manager of their respective functional area		
19	and thus should be compensated accordingly in accordance with the executive		
20	compensation plan which was adopted to provide a compensation system for		
21	county managers.		
22	Consistent with Wisconsin State Statute 59.22(1)(a), sSalary levels for		
23	these positions shall be established no later than December 31 of the year		
24	immediately preceding the year in which the general election for these positions		
25	is to be held. In the event no action is taken with respect to the salary levels by		
26	such date, the salary levels shall continue as previously established. and		
27	maintained as follows:

29	Sheriff - The salary rate for the position of sheriff is established at		
30	the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 20 and the		
31	incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the

33	pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office.

Register of deeds - The salary rate for the position of register of deeds is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 16 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 16 annually, as of the pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office. Effective the term of office which commences in 2003, the salary rate shall be established at the amount provided as of May 1, 2002, of the term of office that commenced in 2001 and shall remain at that rate for the remainder of the term of office.

County clerk - The salary rate for the position of county clerk is established at the equivalent of Rate Step 3 of ECP Salary Grade 16 and the incumbent and successor shall advance to the equivalent of the next highest rate step of ECP Salary Grade 16 annually, as of the pay period which includes the anniversary of the term of office. Effective the term of office which commences in 2003, the salary rate shall be established at the amount provided as of May 1, 2002, of the term of office that commenced in 2001 and shall remain at that rate for the remainder of the term of office.
