20 WAYS YOU CAN SUPPORT FOSTER CARE & ADOPTION IN YOUR COMMUNITY

Inform people in your church:

- Post and distribute information (such as photos, flyers, and bookmarks)
- Devote a bulletin board to Foster Care Month (May) or Adoption Month (November)
- Insert information on ways to help children in church bulletins, folders and newsletters
- Host the Heart Gallery traveling display
- Encourage friends & family to support a child in foster care
- Share your facility: Make available free meeting room space for informational meetings
- Invite a foster/adoption recruiter to speak

Host a "Drive"

- "Clothing Drive" (for kids of all ages)
- "Diaper Drive" (include formula, pull-ups, & blankets)
- "Toiletries Drive" (shampoo, toothpaste, sanitary products)
- "Toy Drive" (include books and games too!)
- "Suitcase Drive" (include duffel bags and backpacks)
- "Stuff the Bus" (school supplies and backpacks)

Select a specific ministry within the church to spearhead the Foster Care ministry:

- Start a foster care and/or adoption support group; designate an individual to work with the Children's Hospital of Wisconsin Community Services recruitment team on meeting the needs of children, foster/adoptive families and birth families.
- Support an existing project created to support foster & adoptive children
- Co-sponsor, host or endorse a special event (such as a picnic, bowling or skating outing; a holiday party for neighborhood children in care; a celebratory event to honor foster parents or adoptive parents)
- Provide support to graduating high school youth in foster care (This could include senior expenses, graduation gifts, prom, educational support and, most important, extended community support beyond foster care)
- Become a respite provider










Number of children placed in foster care by Milwaukee County zip codes 1/2012-2/2014
