45 WHERERAS, upon completion of the new building, the existing 14,000-square-foot structure will be converted solely into a grocery store; and 46 47 48 WHEREAS, Milwaukee's Asian Market Phongsavan's expansion project will cost approximately \$4.1 million, funded primarily through a \$3,346,300, 75% Small Business 49 Administration-backed loan serviced by Ridgestone Bank with \$418,281 in Milwaukee 50 51 Economic Development Corporation participation; and 52 53 WHEREAS, owner equity and WEDC grant funds will be used to cover the 54 remaining project costs; and 55 56 WHEREAS, WEDC grant funds would be used specifically for streetscaping improvements on both the existing building and the new building, including but not 57 58 limited to, landscaping, signage, storefront windows, doors, and awnings; and 59 60 WHEREAS, the required 75% local match requirement is satisfied by the 61 \$3,346,300 loan and owner equity, which account for approximately 94% of project costs; 62 and 63 64 WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic and Community Development, at its 65 meeting of April 14, 2014, recommended adoption of the Department's request (vote 4-0); 66 and 67 68 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of April 69 17, 2014, also recommended adoption of the Department's request (vote 7-0); now, 70 therefore, 71 72 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of County Economic Development is hereby authorized to apply for, and if awarded, accept Community Development Investment 73 74 Grant (CDIG) funds in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 from the Wisconsin Economic 75 Development Corporation (WEDC) to pay for streetscaping improvements for the 76 expansion of Milwaukee's Asian Market Phongsavan; and 77 78 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if awarded the grant, the Department of 79 Administrative Services (DAS)-Economic Development Division is authorized to enter into a CDIG Agreement with WEDC and a Development Agreement with Milwaukee's Asian 80 81 Market Phongsavan, subject to the approval of Risk Management and Corporation Counsel; 82 and 83 84 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Development Agreement shall include at least the following terms and conditions: 85 86 87 (a) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation pursuant to Chapter 42 for the 88 portion of the project funded by the grant. 89 (b) Goal of 25% residential hiring for the portion of the project funded by the grant.

- 90 (c) Good faith efforts to utilize workers from Milwaukee JobCorps where possible on 91 the entire project. (d) Submittal to County of paid itemized invoices for eligible expenses with proof of 92 93 payment for reimbursement purposes, as required by WEDC. (e) Semi-annual performance reporting during the life of the project, with a final report 94 95 due upon completion, as required by WEDC. 96 (f) Reporting for the next several years regarding job creation and retention, leveraged 97 investment, project specific gains, and the increase in the tax base, as required by 98 WEDC. 99 (g) Indemnification in favor of County in the event of a default entitling WEDC to a return of any grant funds expended. 100 (h) Guaranty that County is not responsible for financial obligations of Milwaukee's 101 Asian Market Phongsavan, including but not limited to, loan default by the 102 103 principal. 104 (i) Access to project records during the life of the project and for at least three years 105 thereafter for auditing purposes. 106 107 108 jmj
