The Office of the Comptroller is requesting approval of the attached reimbursement resolution in accordance with US Treasury regulations to allow the County to reimburse itself for expenditures incurred prior to the issuance of the bonds. The maximum amount of the reimbursement resolution is \$3,065,000 and includes estimated costs of issuance and rounding.
- B. Depending upon project implementation, costs incurred prior to the issuance of the bonds would be financed temporarily with general County revenue. However, upon issuance of the bonds the County would be reimbursed for these costs. Although there are no costs associated with the reimbursement resolution, a future resolution authorizing the issuance of debt for the Build Out of Ten Sites to Digital Project would result in future principal and interest expenses. The estimated debt service expenses associated with the additional debt is estimated to be \$3,370,000.
