15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, in April 2013, C.B. Richard Ellis (CBRE) completed a survey of twenty-five Milwaukee County facilities in its Comprehensive Facilities Plan Consulting Report; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) formed a working team to begin implementation of the Consolidated Facilities Plan (CFP) based on CBRE's recommendations; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, at the January 22, 2014, meeting of the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, DAS submitted File No. 14-47, an informational report providing a status update regarding the CFP implementation; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, during the January 22, 2014, presentation of File No. 14-47, Supervisors requested DAS to develop a policy directive to specify a time period for finalizing a broader plan; and
31 32 33 34	WHEREAS, at the June 11, 2014, meeting of the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, DAS submitted File No. 14-483, an informational report that outlines the scope of Phase 3 of the CFP implementation; and
35 36 37 38	WHEREAS, closing City Campus, which has been recommended in the initial plan, requires further planning for the benefit of the health and economic success of its neighborhood and to avoid the blight of a vacant building in this area; and
39 40 41	WHEREAS, File No. 14-483 provides concrete steps toward the necessary downsizing of problematic, County-owned properties; now, therefore,
42 43 44 45 46	BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors and Milwaukee County Department of Administrative Services (DAS) are dedicated to consolidating County facilities, improving County occupied spaces, and selling assets to reduce the County's real estate footprint; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that DAS will finalize the Phase 3 plans of the Consolidated Facilities Plan as scheduled in File No. 14-483, and all implementation actions shall be brought before the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit for approval which includes:

- Relocation of County staff from City Campus into transitional or permanent space by December 31, 2014
- Final agreement with the State related to the utilization of the Marcia Coggs Center by December 31, 2014
- Finalization of an updated County Master Space Plan by June 30, 2015
- A plan for disposition of City Campus property as part of the 2015-16 Budgets
- A comprehensive plan for the County Grounds as part of the 2015-16 Budgets, including strategies for examining Behavioral Health Division Complex facility needs and options as relocation of clients to the community continues, utilization or disposition of the Vel Phillips Juvenile Justice Center, and the utilization or disposition of the Research Park Incubator Building
- A Courthouse Complex Plan, including strategies for utilizing or vacating the Safety Building, Community Correction Center, Office of the Medical Examiner, and the County-owned property at 6<sup>th</sup> and State Street, as part of the 2015-16 Budgets
- Continue County-wide facility and facility management consolidation as part of the 2015-16 Budgets

; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that DAS shall develop a consolidated facilities strategy outline and submit the outline for review to the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit for its January 21, 2015, meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the DAS-Economic Development Division shall meet with local community groups active in the area of City Campus, along with the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee Public Schools staff, to develop a plan for land use regarding City Campus and its surrounding neighborhood, shall address the possibility of demolition with cost estimates, and shall develop recommendations consistent with future development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the development, demolition, if any, and use plans shall be presented to the Committees on Transportation, Public Works and Transit and Economic and Community Development by December 31, 2014, for review by the two Committees in the January 2015 meeting cycle, along with recommendations for further action; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Comptroller is authorized and directed to establish a new capital project titled "City Campus Redevelopment," which shall be used to house any funds appropriated for the purpose of demolition, planning, design, and redevelopment of the site until this project is completed; and
