Supervisor Theodore Lipscomb, Sr., Chairperson, 1 2 From the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, reporting on: 3 File No. 14-627 4 5 (ITEM) From the Office of the Sheriff, requesting authorization to execute the 6 Sixth Amendment to an existing grant with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation 7 8 for provision of a Freeway Service Team for an additional \$125,000, bringing total grant funding to \$1,628,332 and extending the period from July 1, 2014, to December 31, 9 2014, by recommending adoption of the following: 10 11 **A RESOLUTION** 12 13 WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has 14 authorized the Milwaukee County Sheriff to maintain a Freeway Services Team (FST) to 15 operate on the Milwaukee County Freeway System and provide expedited clearance of 16 disabled and crashed vehicles thereby improving safety and minimizing traffic delays 17 and congestion; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has identified the service area as Interstate 94 from the Milwaukee/Racine County line to the Milwaukee/Waukesha County line, 21 Interstate 894 in its entirety, Interstate 43 from downtown Milwaukee to the 22 Milwaukee/Ozaukee County line, Interstate 794 between Carferry Drive and the 23 Marguette Interchange, and United States Route 45 from Interstate 94 to the 24 Milwaukee/Waukesha County line; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County's Sheriff Office will provide a FST to 27 continuously drive the service area, locating, responding to, and clearing minor traffic 28 incidents; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the FST shall assist motorists whose vehicles have suffered 31 mechanical failure or have been involved in minor traffic crashes, and shall be 32 responsible for clearing the traffic lanes of the highway of automobiles, motorcycles, 33 small trucks, and small non-hazardous debris material; and 34 35 36 WHEREAS, the original grant became effective commencing August 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009, and included funding in the amount of \$371,000; and 37 38 39 WHEREAS, there have been five grant amendments extending the original grant through June 30, 2014, with total cumulative funding of \$1,503,332; and 40 41 WHEREAS, this Sixth Amendment to the grant period is for July 1, 2014, through 42 December 31, 2014; and 43

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WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County's Sheriff Office will bill WisDOT on a monthly 45 basis for Deputy Sheriff straight time with overhead included at \$59.74 per hour and 46 overtime hours excluding overhead at \$44.00 per hour; and 47 48 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its 49 meeting of September 11, 2014, recommended adoption of the Office's request (vote 7-50 0); and 51 52 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of 53 54 September 18, 2014, also recommended adoption of the Office's request (vote 9-0); now, therefore, 55 56 BE IT RESOLVED, the Sheriff is hereby authorized to execute the Sixth 57 Amendment to the existing grant with the State of Wisconsin Department of 58 Transportation for provision of a Freeway Service Team on the Milwaukee County 59 Freeway System in the amount of \$125,000, bringing the total cumulative grant funding 60 61 to \$1,628,332. 62 63 64 ag 09/04/14 65 66 H:\Shared\COMCLERK\Committees\2014\Sep\JSGS\Resolutions\14-627.doc
