 - A. Approval of this resolution will deny the proposed position reclassifications submitted by the Department of Human Resources in a report dated August 25, 2014. The reclassifications are related to jobs in the Election Commission and Zoo.
 - B. The fiscal impact statement included in the report states the 2014 fiscal impact for salary, social security and fringe benefits for the reclassified positions to be \$10,509. The full-year cost is \$39,032. No adjustments have been made for any associated revenue that may offset this expense.
 - C. The Department of Administrative Services Fiscal Affairs Division reviewed the reclassifications and indicated that funds would be available this year in each of the affected departments to cover the cost of the position actions. Approval of the reclassifications would increase salary and fringe benefit expenditures, however, it would reduce the amount of surplus salary appropriations that may have otherwise remained at the end of the budget year.
