31	successor contract or subcontract, continued employment for at least 90
32	days, unless the successor contractor or subcontractor demonstrates
33	cause for discontinuation of employment.

35	(4 <u>3</u>)Nothing in this section shall prevent a covered employee, a group of
36	covered employees, or other person adversely affected by a violation of this
37	section from attempting to bring an action against a contractor or
38	subcontractor in a court of competent jurisdiction seeking relief under
39	MCGO Chapter 111. Milwaukee County shall not be liable in any action
40	arising under this Chapter brought by a covered employee, a group of
41	employees, or other person adversely affected violation of this section.
