 - A. The County is currently under an Administrative Order from the WDNR to repair or remove the Estabrook Dam by December 31, 2014. Permission to access the BLM Island is essential to either option. The EA is required prior to BLM granting the requested access. The BLM has directed the DPRC to specify one preferred alternative in the Final EA submitted for their evaluation. The DPRC recommends Dam Removal (Alternative 2) be the preferred Alternative in the Final version of the Environmental Assessment that it will submit to the Bureau of Land Management in support of its previous request for construction access to the island controlled by the BLM situated near the center of the dam structures.
 - B. The Direct Cost of Dam Removal is estimated at \$1,674,000. There would be no long term costs. Dam removal is estimated to cost at least \$844,000 less than the previous alternative and has no annual Operation and Maintenance costs in subsequent years. The Present Worth Analysis indicates a \$3,460,000 savings over 20 years.
 - C. Summary of Budget Sources: Milwaukee County has \$1,600,000 available. WDNR's Municipal Dam Grant Program has allocated \$400,000. The Wisconsin Stewardship Fund has funding up to \$1 million that may be made available to the County for removal. The US Fish and Wildlife Service has authorized a grant for \$220,000. No Annual O&M Costs are needed in the Operating Budget.
 - D. The budget numbers used for these comparisons are based upon the knowledge and experience of the design team and the best estimates available from similar projects.
