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17 18	WHEREAS, DHHS issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for food services on August 11, 2014, with a proposal submission date of September 9, 2014; and
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20 21	WHEREAS, three companies submitted proposals, and the RFP review panel, consisting of representatives from DHHS Management Services Division and DCSD
22	staff, reviewed and scored each of the three proposals; and
23	MULTERAC after the review and appring process concluded and the colligited
24 25	WHEREAS, after the review and scoring process concluded and the solicited "best and final offer" of cost only was submitted, Aramark was the selected vendor; and
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27 28	WHEREAS, Aramark is a privately held Fortune 500 company headquartered in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, with regional offices in Downers Grove, Illinois; and
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30 31	WHEREAS, Aramark is the 23 rd largest employer on the Fortune 500 list, has been in business since 1936, and has staff with extensive food service experience
32	providing food service for the education, healthcare, corrections, and sports and
33	recreation industries in 22 countries; and
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35	WHEREAS, a three-year contract with an option for two additional one-year
36 37	terms is recommended, and the 2015 contract would begin January 1, 2015; and
38	WHEREAS, the total 2015 contract amount, including labor, food, transportation,
39	and supplies, is more cost effective than the current contract; and
