  - A. The Zoo is requesting authority to extend the sky ride contract with SkyZoo of Wisconsin LLC for the years 2015 to 2020.
  - B. The 2015 Budget includes \$251,722 in revenues from the operation of the sky ride. The budget also includes \$188,792 in expenditure authority for SkyZoo's revenue share payment. Net projected profit to the Zoo is \$62,930. The budget also includes reimbursement of \$6,800 from SkyZoo for Zoo labor charges from selling admission tickets for the sky ride.
