9 10 11	WHEREAS, migratory birds are some of the most beautiful and easily observed wildlife that share our communities; and
12 13	WHEREAS, many citizens recognize and welcome migratory songbirds as symbolic harbingers of spring; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS, these migrant species also play an important economic role in our community and assist in controlling insect pests; and
17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, migratory birds and their habitats are declining throughout the Americas, facing a growing number of threats on their migration routes and in both their summer and winter homes; and
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, public awareness and concern are crucial components of migratory bird conservation; and
25 26 27	WHEREAS, citizens enthusiastic about birds, informed about the threats they face, and empowered to help address those threats, can directly contribute to maintaining healthy bird populations; and
28 29 30 31 32 33 34	WHEREAS, since 1993, International Migratory Bird Day (IMBD) has become a primary vehicle for focusing public attention on the nearly 350 species that travel between nesting habitats in our communities and throughout North America and their wintering grounds in South and Central America, Mexico, the Caribbean, and the southern United States; and
35 36 37	WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of people will observe IMBD, gathering in town squares, community centers, schools, parks, nature centers, and wildlife refuges to learn about birds, take action to conserve them, and simply have fun; and
 38 39 40 41 42 42 	WHEREAS, while IMBD is officially held each year on the second Saturday in May, its observance is not limited to a single day, and planners are encouraged to schedule activities on the dates best suited to the presence of both migrants and celebrants; and
43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, IMBD is not only a day to foster appreciation for wild birds and to celebrate and support migratory bird conservation, but also a call to action; now, therefore,
