(ITEM 4) From the Director, Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture, requesting authorization to negotiate agreements with the City of Oak Creek regarding implementation of the Oak Creek bikeway plan on land under the jurisdiction of the Milwaukee County Parks Department and to report back to the Parks Committee and the County Board regarding the proposed agreements, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture has requested authorization to negotiate with the City of Oak Creek to develop an agreement for the construction and maintenance of City of Oak Creek bike trails on land under the jurisdiction of the Milwaukee County Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 1997, the City of Oak Creek adopted the 1998 City of Oak Creek Park and Open Space Plan. The Oak Creek Park and Open Space Plan called for bikeway development throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, under the advisement of the Ad Hoc Bikeway Committee, the Park and Open Space Plan formulated the following goals for the bikeway plan:

1. To designate bikeways along less-traveled streets of the City.

2. To connect all of the City and County Park sites to the bikeway system.

3. To connect the City's industrial parks to the bikeway system.

4. To connect all the City's schools to the bikeway system.

5. To connect the central business district/civic center to the bikeway system.

WHEREAS, to start meeting the goals of the City of Oak Creek Park and Open Space
Plan, members of the City of Oak Creek Planning and Park staff and the County Parks' staff
have met to discuss connections of the bikeway plan into and through Milwaukee County
Parks and Parkways; and

WHEREAS, the bikeway plan has several initiatives in order to meet the City's goals.
The first bikeway development would connect the North Shore - Oak leaf Trail Phase t
construction to the City of Oak Creek Greenlawn Park; and

WHEREAS, the second bikeway development would connect the Oak Creek Parkway Drive east of Howell Avenue to Shepard Avenue; and

WHEREAS, in order to prepare agreements with the City of Oak Creek, the Parks
Director and appropriate County staff require the authority to negotiate the terms of the
