8 Budget Priorities, by recommending adoption of the following:

10 **AN AMENDED RESOLUTION**

12 WHEREAS, the County Board's Legislative Liaison, Office of Government  
13 Affairs, has met with policymakers and departmental staff to develop recommended  
14 State Budget Priorities that will provide policy direction for Milwaukee County's lobbying  
15 efforts during deliberations on the 2015-2017 State of Wisconsin Biennial Budget; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, many of the recommended budget policy directives are long-  
18 standing positions of Milwaukee County that are intended to ensure that adequate  
19 resources are provided to carry out mandated programs and services while protecting  
20 discretionary programs from further cuts; and

22 WHEREAS, the Committee on Intergovernmental Relations, at its meeting of  
23 January 30, 2015, adopted an amendment (vote 4-0) to add Resolution 13-737,  
24 adopted February 6, 2014, to the State Budget Priorities list, which relates to claim  
25 recoupment by insurance companies and third-party payers; and

27 WHEREAS, it is critical that Milwaukee County communicate its key State  
28 Budget Priorities in areas such as mass transit, courts, public safety, health and human  
29 services, and child support enforcement; now, therefore,

31 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby  
32 approve the proposed State Budget Priorities, as amended to include adopted File No.  
33 13-737, a copy hereto attached and made a part of this file, outlining the key budget  
34 priorities for the 2015-2017 session; and

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board's Legislative Liaison, Office of  
37 Government Affairs, is authorized and directed to communicate Milwaukee County's  
38 State Budget Priorities to State policymakers, agency staff, and others to help effectuate  
39 these policy directives.
