

 The Parks Director was directed to review the current CIC project list and make additional capital improvement recommendations to the CIC that could be implemented with the funds provided in this budget.






- Replace HVAC in Pro Shop
- Necessary deferred maintenance






South Shore Park


Currie Park Electric Service Replacement



- Replace main electric distribution service.






Lake Park Ravine Bridge
