## **ISSUE**

A verbal presentation regarding the development of a master plan for Copernicus Park in partnership with the City of Milwaukee and TERRA Engineering.

## **BACKGROUND**

Copernicus Park is a 20.4 acre park located at 2150 West Klein Avenue in the City of Milwaukee (City) and is surrounded by a residential neighborhood. The City approached the DPRC in 2013 with a proposal to partner in the creation of a master plan that would consider park improvements as well as relief from residential flooding and storm water issues. TERRA Engineering was retained to spearhead community outreach and planning and has completed a concept plan with alternatives.
