2015 Unallocated Parks Bonding Funding - \$2,000,000

- The 2015 Capital Improvements Budget included an appropriation of \$9,154,472 for infrastructure improvements to the County parks system.
- During the March Cycle, \$7,154,472 of proposed projects were approved.
- The Parks Director was directed to develop \$2,000,000 in new requested projects based on additional selection criteria.

Proposed Projects

- Three New Restroom & Open Air Shelters will be built at
 - McGovern Park
 - Kern Park
 - Doctors Park
- The new facilities will replace existing structure that have out lived there useful lives.



- The original pool and bathhouse were built in 1937.
- After a fire in 1985, the bathhouse was replaced.
- The pool was removed in the late 1990's.



- Building to be similar to the new Veterans Park Shelter.
- The covered pavilion will be a detached structure.
- Women's restroom is anticipated to consist of (5) toilets and (3) sinks. Men's restroom is anticipated to consist of (2) toilets, (3) urinals and (2) sinks.
- The detached covered pavilion will be 30' x 30' with a concrete slab.
