(ITEM) From the Director, Department of Transportation, requesting authorization to apply for, accept, and execute contracts, and administer Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program grant funds for awardees within the Milwaukee urbanized area for Federal Fiscal Year 2013, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, per Section 59.52(31), Wisconsin Statutes, approval of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors is required to enter into a contract that exceeds \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the current federal transportation authorization legislation Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century created the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program (Section 5310 Program); and

WHEREAS, the Governor appointed Milwaukee County as the sole designated recipient for the Section 5310 Program funds in the Milwaukee urbanized area that includes Ozaukee, Washington, and Waukesha Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) published the full allocation of Federal Fiscal Year 2013 Section 5310 Program funds to the Milwaukee urbanized area, Federal Register (Vol. 78, No. 92) in the amount of \$1,187,949; and

 WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) has evaluated and determined the eligibility requirements of the Section 5310 Program grant applicants, and accordingly, has recommended eight awards in the Milwaukee urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended Goodwill Industries of Southeastern Wisconsin for award of federal funds in the amount of \$110,710 for two dual axle gas minibuses and two minivans; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended Milwaukee Center for Independence for award of federal funds in the amount of \$204,736 and \$5,600 for four Honeycomb medium buses, six mobile devices, and vehicle tracking software, respectively; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended The Threshold, Inc., for award of federal funds in the amount of \$91,196 for one conventional bus; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended Community Care, Inc., for award of federal funds in the amount of \$53,957 for two side entry minivans; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended Interfaith Older Adult Programs for award of federal funds in the amount of \$45,021 and \$44,136 for mobility management and volunteer driver salaries, respectively; and

WHEREAS, SEWRPC has recommended Milwaukee County Transit System for award of federal funds in the amount of \$50,499 for 20 M•CARD revaluing stations; and

WHEREAS, the awardee organizations will be required to provide proof of local match in addition to the federal funds awards amounts cited above in the amount of 20% for all capital improvement related projects, and 50% for operating related projects, and Milwaukee County will require evidence of such matching funds availability prior to executing contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Transportation, will oversee the administration of the Section 5310 Program in order to ensure that funded organizations comply with federal rules and regulations for FTA grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, at its meeting of May 6, 2015, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 7-0) but the recommendation is most under Section 59.52(31)(d), Wisconsin Statutes, which states that only the County Board's Finance Committee has jurisdiction over contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of May 14, 2015, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 8-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Transportation, is hereby authorized to apply for, accept, execute contracts, and administer Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program grant funds for awardees within the Milwaukee urbanized area for Federal Fiscal Year 2013 funds.
