WHEREAS, on March 1, 2004, Milwaukee County entered into Airport Agreement No. CN-1412 with Paradies-Mark II, LLC (Paradies) for the non-exclusive right to operate news, gift, and specialty retail concessions at General Mitchell International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was for a term of seven years with three one-year options, and is continuing on a month-to-month basis through February 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, there is a current need for additional news stand services at the north end of Concourse D that would better serve Delta Airline passengers; and

WHEREAS, Paradies is requesting that approximately 140 square feet of space be added to Airport Agreement No. CN-1412 at the north end of Concourse D for the placement of a wall unit through which to sell beverages, snacks, and reading materials; and
