1 Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., Chairperson, 2 From the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, reporting on: 3 4 File No. 15-425 5 6 ) A resolution by Supervisor Mayo, Sr., reconstituting the Transit Services (ITEM 7 Advisory Committee (TSAC) granting authorization to modify the membership term 8 lengths and structure within the TSAC bylaws to devise a new procedure for recruiting and phasing out memberships during transition periods until June 2019, by 9 10 recommending adoption of the following: 11 12 **A RESOLUTION** 13 14 WHEREAS, File No. 05-293 adopted in June 2005, established the Transit 15 Services Advisory Committee (TSAC), which was appointed by the Chairperson of the 16 Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) in 2007 and was given the 17 charge of obtaining comments and identifying strengths and weaknesses within the 18 Milwaukee County Transit System; and 19 20 WHEREAS, TSAC was previously reestablished in 2012 through adopted File 21 No. 12-549, which resolved that appointed members of TSAC would serve a three-year 22 term with a committee sunset date of June 2015; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the County Board appoints the members of TSAC to provide non-25 binding advisory input on issues of public transportation; and 26 27 WHEREAS, in order to ensure the continuity and preservation of TSAC's 28 knowledge and leadership, a managed term structure that would allow members to 29 serve in staggered time frames would be an appropriate and strategic approach to 30 maintain a level of consistency of institutional knowledge during transition periods; and 31 32 WHEREAS, implementing a managed, staggered term structure will not impinge 33 on the existing authority of the Chairperson of the County Board to make or cancel 34 appointments to TSAC; and 35 36 WHEREAS, staggered terms are a consistent practice amongst similarly 37 structured committees and commissions; and 38 39 WHEREAS, the members of TSAC are volunteers and the implementation of a 40 new term structure will have no additional budgetary impact; and 41 42 WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, at its 43 meeting of June 10, 2015, recommended adoption of the resolution (vote 7-0); now,

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therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Transit Services Advisory Committee (TSAC) shall continue to remain active and operational, with a sunset of June 2019, and is authorized to devise a procedure for recruiting, nominating, and phasing out its memberships, and will amend the TSAC bylaws accordingly; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, TSAC will continue to meet quarterly and submit periodic written recommendations regarding various aspects of transit services and transit policy issues to the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit and to the Milwaukee County Transit System; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, TSAC shall continue its role of making recommendations to the transit operator regarding route changes, service modifications, long range plan updates, major and new project development, shelter location and improvements, headway changes greater than five minutes, public relations campaigns and events, proposed bus stop changes, and fare changes; hear public comments; and reviewing correspondence submitted to TSAC by the public; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Chairperson of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) shall continue to maintain the authority of appointing and removing the members of TSAC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, TSAC shall submit timely, written reports on any membership changes to the Chairperson of the County Board and to the Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit.
