10 11	WHEREAS, major transportation investments in and around the I-94 East-West Corridor have a direct economic impact on Milwaukee County; and

13 14 15	WHEREAS, transportation connectivity to Milwaukee and other communities in the region to major economic and activity centers, such as Mayfair Mall, the Regional Medical Center, the Milwaukee Veterans Affairs Medical Center, and to other points in
16	between is vital to Milwaukee County's economy; and
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18	WHEREAS, housing and commercial developments in and around Milwaukee
19	County are increasingly transit-oriented and would benefit from a multi-modal system
20	that spurs economic development and enhanced mobility; and
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22	WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has declared
23	an "at-grade" expansion, which would add one lane in each direction to I-94 between
24	16 th and 70 th Streets at a cost of \$850 million, as its preferred alternative; and
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26	WHEREAS, the justification for this highway expansion is based on questionable
27	predictions of increasing traffic volumes, despite data showing that traffic along the I-94
28	East-West Corridor declined by 8% from 2002 through 2012; and
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30	WHEREAS, WisDOT failed to adequately study and prematurely dismissed non-
31	expansion options for the Corridor, including transit, and did not consider how such
32	alternatives might more positively affect Milwaukee County communities than costly
33	expansion options; and
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35	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County residents, in their role as Wisconsin and Federal
36	taxpayers, will be asked to pay their share of this \$850 million highway expansion
37	project; and
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39	WHEREAS, wasteful and unneeded highway expansions such as this one divert
40	hundreds of millions of dollars away from local road maintenance and from local public
41	transit systems, including the amount of state assistance available to Milwaukee County
42	to help meet local transportation needs; and
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44	WHEREAS, WisDOT's preferred expansion will increase air and waterway
45	pollution in and around Milwaukee County; and
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- 47 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County and the region need transportation solutions including transit improvements that enhance mobility, safety, workforce connectivity, 48 and the quality of life for all residents, but such solutions have not been offered or 49 50 planned by WisDOT; and 51 WHEREAS, WisDOT's preferred expansion option will reduce highway access to 52 key businesses and engines of economic development in the region, while not adding a 53 54 lane would maintain full local access; and 55 WHEREAS, the Coalition for More Responsible Transportation (Coalition) has 56 developed a better, more cost-effective alternative for the I-94 East-West Corridor that 57 would directly benefit Milwaukee County by connecting communities and residents to 58 the region's major economic centers, and to other economic and activity centers; and 59 60 WHEREAS, the Coalition's plan calls for: 61 62 63 1. Repair of the highway with spot improvements, without adding lanes 2. Incorporation of an East-West transit system into the I-94 project plan 64 65 ;and 66 WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, at its 67 meeting of June 10, 2015, recommended adoption of the resolution (vote 5-2); now, 68 therefore. 69 70 BE IT RESOLVED, Milwaukee County opposes the Wisconsin Department of 71 Transportation's expansion proposal of the I-94 East-West Corridor, and supports the 72 "Rehab/Transit Option" put forth by the Coalition for More Responsible Transportation. 73 74 75 76 srb 77 06/10/15
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
