14 15	SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended as follows:

17	When immediate action is required to preserve property or protect life, health or	
18	welfare of persons, any department head is authorized to procure equipment,	
19	supplies and services directly in the open market. The procurement division shall be consulted and/or notified. Such action shall be reported, in writing, within forty

21	eight (48) hours after initial emergency action, in the county board, county	
22 23	executive and department of administration. Purchases and payments shall not be restricted by normal budget limitations. Appropriation transfers, if required,	
24	shall be initiated in accordance with fiscal procedures	
25	32.33 Encumbrance of funds.	
26	Except for an emergency as identified in section 32.28, nNo order for supplies,	
27	materials, equipment or contractual services shall be awarded until the division of	
28	fiscal affairs certifies that the unencumbered balance in the appropriation(s)	
29	concerned is sufficient to defray the cost of such order.	
30	SECTION 2. Chapter 56 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is	
31	amended as follows:	
32	56.30(4)(b)(3)(b)	
33	For a professional services contract with a value of fifty thousand dollars	
34	(\$50,000.00) or more, approval by the county board is required. Such approval	
35	may take place as part of the county board's adoption of the annual county budget. If approval does not take place as part of the adopted budget, then	
36 37	review by the appropriate county board standing committee and approval by the	
38	county board is required. If immediate action is required to preserve property or	
39	protect life, health and welfare of persons, county board approval may be waived,	
40	provided such action shall be reported, in writing, within forty-eight (48) hours
