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(ITEM) From the Capital Finance Manager, Office of the Comptroller, requesting authorization to execute an administrative fund transfer to receive lease payment revenue from the Milwaukee Yacht Club and to deposit the funds into the Debt Service Reserve to offset \$18.7 million in debt issued for improvements to McKinley Marina; and notifying policymakers of a change in use for the \$150,000 payment from 2008 and the payment plan for the \$175,000 payment from 2013, by recommending adoption of the following:

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) entered into a lease agreement with the Milwaukee Yacht Club (MYC) that included the construction of a facility with ownership to revert to the County at the end of the term; and

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the initial lease was from 1966 to 1991, with renewal for another 25 years upon approval by County policymakers; and

WHEREAS, the current lease is for the years 1992-2017, with renewal for another 25 years upon agreement and approval by County policymakers; and

WHEREAS, the current lease specifies that the MYC must notify the County of its intention to negotiate a renewal term two years prior to January 10, 2017, and the MYC did so on March 20, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) is in the process of drafting a lease for the MYC that will be negotiated in the Spring of 2016; and

WHEREAS, the DPRC began receiving annual rent and MYC parking fees in 1994 and these amounts have been included and budgeted as general revenues for the DPRC; and

WHEREAS, the agreement also included the payment by the MYC of five balloon payments totaling \$750,000 over the term of the lease:

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 1999 - \$100,000

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 2003 - \$125,000

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 2008 - \$150,000

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 2013 - \$175,000

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 2018 - \$200,000

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WHEREAS, in 1999, the first balloon payment of \$100,000 was due and budgeted in the Miscellaneous Revenue budget to offset costs associated with the construction of the breakwater and dockage at McKinley Marina and the County spent approximately \$18.7 million from 1994 to 2001 for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the balloon payments for the years 1999, 2003, and 2008 were budgeted in the Miscellaneous Revenue budget for the respective years and the County did not receive the \$150,000 balloon payment budgeted in 2008; and

WHEREAS, the DPRC is responsible for collecting the lease payments and although it is not clear why the revenue was not collected, there were a number of staff changes in the DPRC's fiscal department as well as in the Fiscal Affairs Division, Department of Administrative Services (DAS) (now known as the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, DAS); and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the MYC requested permission from the DPRC to use the \$150,000 (2008 balloon payment), along with \$50,000 of MYC funds, to pay for the dredging of the Flushing Channel; and

WHEREAS, in February of 2012, the DPRC sent correspondence to the MYC allowing them to use the \$150,000 to dredge the Flushing Channel; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the County did not receive the \$175,000 balloon payment that was due in 2013; and

WHEREAS, a 2015 communication from the DPRC to the MYC indicates that they were in default of the lease due to non-payment of the 2013 balloon payment; and

 WHEREAS, the DPRC met with the MYC in May of 2015 and developed a payment plan for the MYC to pay the \$175,000 that was due in 2013 in installments in lieu of finding the MYC in default and all payments are due 15 days after the end of the quarter; and

WHEREAS, the MYC has signed the payment plan and the DPRC communicated to the MYC that if it failed to make the payments that the MYC would be in immediate default of the existing lease and, to date, the MYC has made all payments in accordance with the plan; and

WHEREAS, the plan is contingent on the MYC's successful completion of its due diligence obligations by July 15, 2015, and successful completion of all subsequent and timely lease negotiations with the DPRC; and

WHEREAS, preliminary financial statements were submitted to the DPRC by July 15, 2015; and

91 WHEREAS, all other due diligence requirements will be due closer to lease 92 execution, by the current timeline of June 2016, and if lease negotiations with the MYC are not timely, the DPRC reserves the right to find the MYC in default under the terms of 93 94 the lease; and 95 WHEREAS, all parties are meeting timeline established deadlines; and 96 97 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of 98 December 10, 2015, recommended adoption of the Capital Finance Manager's request 99 (vote 6-0); now, therefore, 100 101 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby 102 authorizes and directs the Department of Administrative Services, with assistance from 103 the Office of the Comptroller, to prepare and execute an administrative transfer to 104 receive lease payment revenue from the Milwaukee Yacht Club and deposit the funds 105 into the Debt Service Reserve to offset approximately \$18.7 million in debt issued for 106 improvements to McKinley Marina. 107 108 109 110 jmj 12/10/15 111 112 S:\Committees\2015\Dec\FPA\Resolutions\15-756.doc
