A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to increase an existing 2015 purchase of service contract with Southwest Key in the amount of \$64,005 from \$700,515 to \$764,520 for services in the Delinquency and Court Services Division (DCSD) for the period January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

In accordance with Milwaukee County's RFP process, a 2015 contract in the amount of \$700,515 was executed with Southwest Key for the provision of Level II in home monitoring services for pre-dispositional youth (who are pending a delinquency petition) as an alternative to secure detention. Approval of this request will allow for the expansion of the Level II Program by an additional 15 slots (from the current 66 to the new total of 81 slots). This expansion will help alleviate the issue of a potential waiting list and allow youth to start participation in the program as soon as possible.

- B. Total 2015 expenditures included in this request are \$64,005.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request in 2015 as funds sufficient to cover this expenditure are included as part of DCSD's 2015 Budget.
- D. It is assumed that total expenditures will not exceed the contract amount.
