(ITEM) From the Capital Improvements Committee (CIC) Chairperson, requesting authorization to amend Chapter 36 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to streamline the CIC requests process, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, as a result of the 2013 Adopted Budget and a subsequent ordinance amendment, Chapter 36 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (hereinafter Chapter 36) was created which founded the Capital Improvements Committee (CIC) and established its duties and due dates; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) and County Executive amended Chapter 36 to temporarily change the due dates (for 2014 and 2015) and make two permanent changes; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 36 currently (for 2016 and future years) requires the following due dates:

 By April 15 of each year – Departments submit five-year capital improvements plan requests to the appropriate County Board Standing Committee.

 By May 15 of each year – the CIC provides a five-year capital improvements plan to the County Board and County Executive.

• By May 15 of each year – the CIC submits an evaluation of each capital budget recommendation.

WHEREAS, the CIC is requesting changes to Chapter 36 that will streamline the CIC process; and

WHEREAS, the changes if adopted in their totality, will allow Departments to submit a single set of capital improvement requests to both the CIC and through the normal County Board/County Executive process; and

WHEREAS, the changes in this resolution would amend Chapter 36 by including the following:

 Departments will submit their capital requests to the CIC on the same date that they submit their capital requests to the County Executive. However, the requests must be submitted by July 30. The requests will be made available to the County Board and County Executive.

- The capital improvements committee shall develop a five-year capital (a) improvements plan. In 2014 and 2015, by June 30 and in future years by April 15 of each year, d Department heads shall submit their five-year capital improvements plan requests to the staff of the capital improvements committee at the same time as the requests are submitted to the department of administrative services. These requests shall be the same. appropriate standing committees of the county board, who shall then submit the plans, including their recommendations, to the capital improvements committee. The requests for the first year must include supporting data, justifications, cost estimates and operating impacts for proposed projects. The requests for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th years must include department priority ranking. Based on this review of projects submitted and of critical needs, tThe capital improvements committee shall submit a five-year capital improvements plan to the county board and the county executive <u>based on established criteria</u>. The staff of the capital improvements committee will work with the Department of Administrative Services to establish the due dates for the requested capital improvement projects from departments and recommended five year capital improvement plan from the CIC to the County Board and County Executive. by September 1 in 2014 and 2015 and in future years by May 15 of each year for adoption in conjunction with adoption of the annual budget:
- (b) Based on established criteria, by September 1 in 2014 and in 2015 and in future years by May 15 of each year, the capital improvements committee shall submit to the department of administrative services, on forms prescribed by the department, an evaluation of each and every capital budget recommendation submitted by county departments, agencies and offices, including ratings, prioritized rankings, financing, and how each project serves to implement the five-year capital improvements plan; said report shall also be provided to the county board of supervisors.

36.05. - Staffing.

Effective July 31, 2014, sStaff for the capital improvements committee shall be responsible to perform all work duties and responsibilities related to the capital improvements committee and shall be provided by the Office of the Comptroller, and, in this role, shall operate under the administrative direction of the committee. All county departments, agencies and offices shall cooperate with the committee, and the committee staff, including the department of administrative services-performance, strategy and budget administration and fiscal affairs division and provide assistance whenever the committee so requests.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.

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
