19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, the freeway towing program is administered on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, by ordinance, through the Director's Office of the Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT); and
23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, freeway towing is currently divided into five geographic sectors covering Milwaukee County and MCDOT currently holds six contracts with three vendors that provide freeway towing services according to weight classes within each individual geographic sector as follows:

40 41 42 43 44	WHEREAS, the term of the current freeway towing contracts covers the period from April 1, 2011, through March 31, 2016, and MCDOT requests authorization to extend the term of the current freeway towing contracts from March 31, 2016, through July 31, 2016, where all other terms and conditions of the current freeway towing contracts remain the same; and

45 46 WHEREAS, the requested extension will allow MCDOT sufficient time to 47 competitively solicit towing services through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process 48 and the proposed contracts to be awarded as an outcome of the RFP process will then 49 be brought forward for County Board approval prior to an expected implementation date 50 of August 1, 2016; and 51 52 WHEREAS, approval to amend the current freeway towing contracts from March 53 31, 2016, through July 31, 2016, has no fiscal impact as annual towing revenue of 54 \$240,000 is already included in the Adopted 2016 operating budget for MCDOT; and 55 56 WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation, Public Works, and Transit, at its 57 meeting of January 20, 2016, considered this resolution for informational purposes only; 58 and 59 60 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of 61 January 28, 2016, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 8-0); now, 62 therefore, 63 64 BE IT RESOLVED, the Director, Department of Transportation, is authorized to 65 amend the contracts with the freeway towing providers extending the current contracts 66 from March 31, 2016, through July 31, 2016. 67 68 69 70 71 jmj 01/28/16

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
