1 By Supervisor Weishan, Jr. File No. 16-118 2 3 4 ) From the Director of Family Care, recommending adoption of the following (ITEM 5 resolution relating to transferring the family care program to a nonprofit corporation, with appropriate compensation to the County, in order that services may continue to be 6 7 provided to adults with disabilities and frail elderly persons who are now receiving them: 8 9 A SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION 10 11 12 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Department of Family Care (operating as My Choice Family Care "MCFC") administers long term care and support services to adults 13 14 with disabilities and frail elderly persons through the State of Wisconsin Family Care 15 program; and 16 17 WHEREAS, MCFC administers long term care and support services to 18 approximately 8,400 persons in Milwaukee County and seven other Wisconsin counties; 19 and 20 21 WHEREAS, MCFC has successfully provided the Family Care benefit to over 22 25,000 persons since 2000, maintaining high quality standards for members while being 23 cost effective: and 24 25 WHEREAS, MCFC benefits the local community by providing workers with a 26 living wage, contracting with over 1,100 community agencies, directly employing over 27 70 county employees, and employing over 300 care managers and nurses in the 28 community; and 29 30 WHEREAS, under Chapter 46 of the Wisconsin Statutes as amended by 2015 31 Wisconsin Act 55, the state now requires that to remain a participating care organization 32 under the Family Care program after December 31, 2016, MCFC must obtain HMO 33 licensure: and 34 35 WHEREAS, neither Milwaukee County nor MCFC operating as a department of 36 Milwaukee County can obtain HMO licensure; and 37 38 WHEREAS, these State changes are an unacceptable attack on local control 39 and a thinly veiled attempt to turn over Family Care to large, for-profit, managed care organizations; now, therefore, 40 41 42 BE IT RESOLVED, that Milwaukee County opposes the privatization of the 43 Milwaukee County Department of Family Care; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Milwaukee County requests the Federal
Agency, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, to deny the waiver requested
by the State of Wisconsin, which would allow MCO administration of Family Care
statewide, rather than by geographic region, essentially eliminating the Milwaukee
County Department of Family Care and causing statewide privatization of the Family
Care program; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the waiver is granted to the State,

52 Milwaukee County requests the State of Wisconsin make appropriate changes and/or 53 waivers to allow MCFC to obtain HMO licensure and remain a County entity; and

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55 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Clerk shall forward a 56 copy of this resolution to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the 57 Governor of the State of Wisconsin, and the Milwaukee County Delegation in the State 58 Legislature.
