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10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, as a result of the 2013 Adopted Budget and a subsequent ordinance amendment, Chapter 36 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (hereinafter Chapter 36) was created which founded the Capital Improvements Committee (CIC) and established its duties and due dates; and
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15 16 17	WHEREAS, in 2014, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) and County Executive amended Chapter 36 to temporarily change the due dates (for 2014 and 2015) and make two permanent changes; and
18 19	WHEREAS, Chapter 36 currently (for 2016 and future years) requires the

22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	 By April 15 of each year – Departments submit five-year capital improvements plan requests to the appropriate County Board Standing Committee. By May 15 of each year – the CIC provides a five-year capital improvements plan to the County Board and County Executive. By May 15 of each year – the CIC submits an evaluation of each capital budget recommendation.

31 32 33 34	WHEREAS, the CIC is requesting changes to Chapter 36 that will streamline the CIC process; and
35 36 37 38	WHEREAS, the changes if adopted in their totality, will allow Departments to submit a single set of capital improvement requests to both the CIC and through the normal County Board/County Executive process; and
39 40 41	WHEREAS, the changes in this resolution would amend Chapter 36 by including the following:
42 43 44 45	• Departments will submit their capital requests to the CIC on the same date that they submit their capital requests to the County Executive. However, the requests must be submitted by July 30. The requests will be made available to the County Board and County Executive.

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47	 Departments will submit the same requests to the CIC and the County
48	Executive. This will help to limit the variances between the CIC's
49	recommended budget and the budget ultimately adopted by policymakers.
50	• The CIC will provide its recommendations to the County Board and County
51	Executive by September 15.
52	Departments will submit requests directly to the staff of the CIC instead of
53	submitting requests to Standing Committees and then having the Standing
54	Committees refer the requests to the CIC.

The capital improvements committee shall develop a five-year capital 97 (a) improvements plan. In 2014 and 2015, by June 30 and in future years by April 15 98 99 of each year, d Department heads shall submit their five-year capital improvements plan requests to the staff of the capital improvements committee 100 at the same time as the requests are submitted to the department of 101 administrative services. These requests shall be the same. appropriate standing 102 committees of the county board, who shall then submit the plans, including their 103 recommendations, to the capital improvements committee. The requests for the 104 first year must include supporting data, justifications, cost estimates and 105 operating impacts for proposed projects. The requests for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th 106 years must include department priority ranking. The staff of the capital 107 improvements committee shall submit an informational report to the capital 108 improvements committee and all standing committees that lists and summarizes 109 the capital requests. Based on this review of projects submitted and of critical 110 111 needs, tThe capital improvements committee shall submit a five-year capital improvements plan to the county board and the county executive based on 112 established criteria. The staff of the capital improvements committee will work 113 with the Department of Administrative Services to establish the due dates for the 114 requested capital improvement projects from departments and recommended 115 five year capital improvement plan from the CIC to the County Board and County 116 Executive. by September 1 in 2014 and 2015 and in future years by May 15 of 117 each year for adoption in conjunction with adoption of the annual budget; 118 Based on established criteria, by September 1 in 2014 and in 2015 and in future 119 (b) years by May 15 of each year, the capital improvements committee shall submit 120 to the department of administrative services, on forms prescribed by the 121 department, an evaluation of each and every capital budget recommendation 122 submitted by county departments, agencies and offices, including ratings, 123 prioritized rankings, financing, and how each project serves to implement the 124 five-year capital improvements plan; said report shall also be provided to the 125 county board of supervisors. 126

128 **36.05. - Staffing.**

Effective July 31, 2014, sStaff for the capital improvements committee shall be 129 responsible to perform all work duties and responsibilities related to the capital 130 improvements committee and shall be provided by the Office of the Comptroller, and, in 131 this role, shall operate under the administrative direction of the committee. All county 132 departments, agencies and offices shall cooperate with the committee, and the 133 committee staff, including the department of administrative services-performance, 134 strategy and budget administration and fiscal affairs division and provide assistance 135 136 whenever the committee so requests.
