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Section 2. Chapter 1.27 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is

The chairperson of the county board is the head of the department of the county board for purposes of having budgeting and personnel oversight authority over all county board staff, overseeing departmental operations, approving departmental expenditures, and submitting requested budgets, and, as delegated and approved by the board, to initiate an action for declaratory, injunctive, or other extraordinary relief or remedy seeking to preserve, enforce, and defend the legal rights and status of the board in relation to other branches of county government or elected county officials.

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
